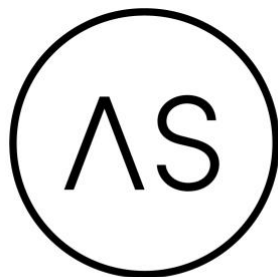

Biography

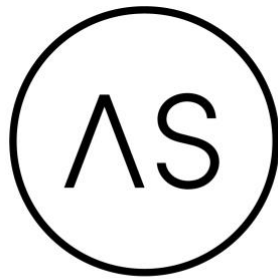
Chloe has always been a natural performer and a highly ambitious creative.
